National and local fair housing testing has shown that local senior citizens are at a heightened risk for becoming victims of predatory housing practices based upon their age, disability status, race and national origin. This workshop will discuss the types of discrimination faced by seniors in our community as well as what is being done locally to raise awareness and prevent discrimination.
