## Fair Housing Rights Training for Senior Advocates in Kent County

The Fair Housing Center of West Michigan is pleased to offer a FREE training on fair housing rights for seniors and those serving seniors in Kent County. Topics include:

- overview of the protections for senior citizens under fair housing law;
- data on the current state of fair housing for seniors; and
- trends in housing discrimination experienced by seniors, including policies, practices, advertising and treatment, that create barriers to housing choice.

Attendees will also learn more about the broad implications of housing discrimination for Kent County as well as what services the FHCWM offers.

The training is offered *free of charge* through the Kent County Senior Millage. Advanced registration is required. This training may appeal to outreach workers, social service agencies, seniors, civil rights/disability rights advocates, those serving seniors or people with disabilities, and others interested in aging in place.
