Fair Housing Rights Training for Senior Advocates in Kent County

The Fair Housing Center of West Michigan is pleased to offer a FREE training on fair housing rights for seniors and those serving seniors in Kent County. Topics include:

- overview and updates regarding the protections for senior citizens under federal, state and local fair housing laws;
- data on the current state of fair housing for seniors;
- definitions and examples of reasonable accommodations and modifications for seniors with disabilities;
- best practices for making or providing support requests for accommodations and modifications in senior housing.

Attendees will also learn more about the broad implications of housing discrimination for Kent County as well as what services the FHCWM offers.

The training is offered *free of charge* through the Kent County Senior Millage. Advanced registration is required. This training may appeal to outreach workers, social service agencies, seniors, civil rights/disability rights advocates, those serving seniors or people with disabilities, and others interested in aging in place. Participants must be advocates for seniors in Kent County.
